

eyetesting

A regular two yearly eye test is recommended to help maintain the health of your eyes and good vision.

Children should also have regular eye tests as undetected vision problems can severely impact their education, social and physical development.

An eyetest is free with your Medicare Card, even if you have had an eyetest within 2 years. The test itself takes approximately 30 minutes. It includes your pressures being checked to guard against or monitor Glaucoma and a retinal photograph being taken, free of charge, to assess your eye health and provide a permanent record.

HEALTH FUNDS



Most health fund rebates will cover the cost of a spectacle frame from our extensive Budget Beauties range and standard single vision, bifocal or progressive lenses. In most cases this means that you will have no out of pocket expenses or a small amount to pay, as minimum rebate levels apply.

If you want to upgrade by purchasing from our Affordable Fashion or Design Design Range, your rebate will be maximised. If you are unsure of how much you will get from your health fund please bring your card into us and we'll be able to advise you.

takehomelay**by**
Pay for your purchase while you use it

Takehomelayby allows you to pay for your spectacles while you wear them by breaking down the overall expense of purchasing eyewear, into manageable bite-size amounts payable over 4 months. Please ask instore for our information sheet.

government spectacles scheme

If you hold a Queensland Concession Card you may be eligible for free spectacles or discounts. A current See and Save prescription is required. Appointments available Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday afternoons.

veterans affairs

If you hold a Veterans Affairs Card we hold an approved range of spectacle frames and lenses. It is always a good idea to bring along your card when making an appointment so we can establish your entitlement.

warranties - 30 day satisfaction guarantee

If you are dissatisfied with your spectacle choice or prescription lenses, within 30 days of your purchase you can exchange, once. If the value is greater you will only be charged the difference, if the value is less, no refunds are given. To exchange your frames, lenses and case they need to be in their original condition.

2 month multi-focal lens warranty

If you are a multi-focal wearer, be prepared that it may take up to 2 weeks before you are fully comfortable with these lenses. After this period of wear, if you cannot get along with your multi-focals we can exchange them for Bifocal, Extended Reading or Single Vision Lenses. This is at no extra charge to you, however, no refunds are given.

12 month faults and defects warranty

If your spectacles or sunglasses have a fault or defect we will replace or repair for a one year period from the date of purchase. Excludes sale items and general wear and tear.
